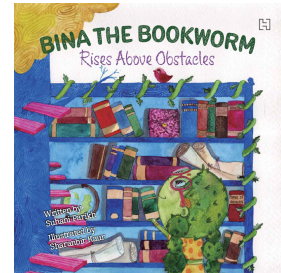

A fun-to-read picture book that celebrates the power of words and stories for young readers beginning to enjoy reading.

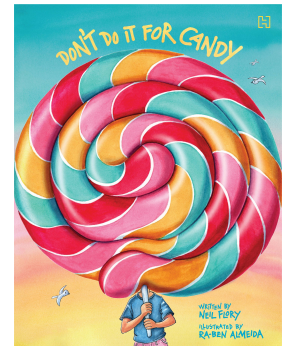
ABOUT THE AUTHOR (or Editor/Illustrator/Translator)

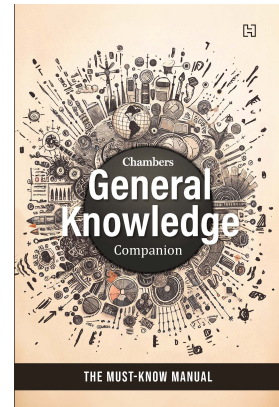
